Counselling Diploma

STAGE 1: £4,655 plus residential cost £990, **total £5,645** (Initial payment £1,235 plus 9 x £490 monthly)

STAGE 2: £5,400 plus residential cost £990, **total £6,390** (Initial payment £1,530 plus 9 x £540 monthly)

STAGE 3: £5,400 plus residential cost £990, **total £6,390** (Initial payment £1,530 plus 9 x £540 monthly)

Psychotherapy Diploma

STAGE 4: £5,230 plus residential cost £990, **total £6,220** (Initial payment £1,540 plus 9 x £520 monthly)

STAGE 5: £5,230 (indicative) plus residential cost £990, **total £6,220** (Initial payment £1,540 plus 9 x £520 monthly)

Unfortunately the training is not eligible for student or adult learner loans.

A limited number of bursaries are available to candidates who fulfil the criteria. Please ask for details. Bursaries are awarded for training fees only and not for the residential costs.

Please note that there will be an increase in fees on an annual basis. We keep the increase as low as we can to cover our costs.

A discount of 2.5% can be made on the basic training fees (not the residential element) for payment in full by the date your deposit would be due. Please note that the discount for payment in full is not applicable if you are in receipt of a bursary.

We wish to make our diploma training as accessible as possible and not limited by financial means. If you are able to pay for your course fees in full without receiving the early payment discount, please consider paying the full rate and the surplus fee will be allocated entirely towards our bursary programme.

These fees are inclusive of all groups, including supervision in stages 2-5. They include costs for summer and winter residential events. These costs are usually based on a 2 night weekend residential in January and 4 nights in July. Re-Vision strives to keep the costs within these limits, but if it proves impossible, it may be necessary to raise this residential element.

Additional Costs of Training to Consider

Personal therapy - Students are expected to engage in a minimum number of hours of personal therapy per academic year (minimum 35 hours per year for counselling students, minimum 40 hours per year for psychotherapy students). You will have to self-fund this therapy. The estimated cost of therapy is £50-£80 per hour. Some therapists offer concessions for trainees.

Professional membership - All students are required to be members of a professional body. Counselling students are required to become members of BACP (British Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy) or NCPS (National Counseling and Psychotherapy Society) from the start of Stage 2 onwards. Current

student membership fees at BACP are £86 per year and at NCPS are either £60 or £30 depending on your personal financial situation.

All students who are seeing clients are also encouraged to become trainee members of UKCP (UK Council for Psychotherapy). Trainee membership of UKCP is currently £75 per year.

Supervision for clinical practice - As part of your training you will need a significant number of supervision hours, broadly calculated as a minimum of 1 hour per 6 hours of client work. At Re-Vision, the cost of your training supervision is included in your course fees. As supervision generally costs between £50 and £80 per hour, this is a significant financial benefit.

Insurance - While you are on placement or if you are working privately, you will need insurance. Some placements organisational insurance will cover you, but if not, then you will need to take out your own insurance. You will need to determine the type and level of cover that is right for your particular circumstances. Data protection - The *Data Protection (Charges and Information) Regulations 2018* requires every organisation or sole trader who processes personal information to pay a data protection fee to the ICO (Information Commissioner's Office) unless they are exempt. Personal data is information that relates to or identifies an individual. Many placement providers will have organisational registration in place, which means you do not need to register yourself (because you are in such cases *not* the 'data controller'). If you are required to register, the current annual fee is £40 (- £5 discount for direct debit payment).

Students entering Stage 4 via the Additional Prior Learning route - For each APL student we make a case by case assessment of how many hours of training are needed to meet all the course requirements, based on individual circumstances. These might include additional tutorials and/or group study sessions, which would incur a cost, as well as reading and self-study, which would not incur a direct cost. We endeavour to keep these additional costs to a minimum, and these costs will be discussed with you as part of the admissions process. For information, we estimate the additional fee for each student, to be assessed on a case by case basis, will be less than £500.
